

Message from Seminarian Bailey



I'm always amused by the line in today's Gospel where Mark describes that Jesus is unable to perform any mighty deed in his native place, except, of course, from miraculously curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. While I'd consider those deeds sufficiently mighty, Jesus always desires to do more for us.

Mark highlights the lack of faith of the people as a reason why Jesus is unable to do more, but I think an equally important reason is that those listening took offense at him. "Where did this man get all this? What kind of wisdom has been given him?" In other words, "What can Jesus do for me that I can't already do for myself?"

In a world where we are used to taking care of ourselves, and in a world where we are well equipped to do so, I think that we can sometimes believe we don't need Jesus. We can become hard of face and obstinate of heart like the Israelites. and, in our eager attempt to free ourselves of our sufferings and sins, we prevent Jesus from being who He is: our Savior.

We hear from St. Paul today that weaknesses, insults, hardships, and persecutions aren't meant to be obstacles that we overcome by our own power, but opportunities to call out to Christ and give him permission to perform mighty deeds for us. In this way, we are made strong in our weakness.

In this month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus, let us call out more earnestly to the one who endured insults, hardships, and persecutions on the cross for us, and let Him do all the mighty things that He desires.


